PAKISTAN FLOOD RESPONSE

REPORT



THE SITUATION

The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) of Pakistan reports some **33 million people affected** by unprecedented flooding and landslides across the country.

The Government of Pakistan has declared a <u>national emergency</u> in the country, with 116 districts affected, including 66 districts officially declared 'calamity hit'.

Around 2 million acres of crops and orchards have also been negatively impacted. Over 1,300 people have lost their lives.

There is a looming risk of water-borne diseases in the coming months leading into frigid winters.

EMERGENCY SUPPLY ITEMS

What's included?

FOOD PACK

- 20 kg pack of wheat flour
- 3 liters of cooking oil
- 7 kg Basmati rice
- 2 kg sugar
- 2.5kg of lentils

- 250g tea
- 1 packet of iodized salt
- 1 pack of red chilies powder

HYGIENE KIT

- 8 strips of water purificati (aqua tabs) – 100 tablets
- 2 12L jerry cans
- 3 cotton towels
- 4 bars of antibacterial soap
- 8 strips of water purification 4 bars of laundry soap
 - 2 nail cutters
 - 3 toothbrushes
 - 1 toothpaste

SHELTER SUPPLY

- 320 Shelter Tents (Single Ply) and
- 320 Tarpaulin Sheets (Weight 180 gm)
